She was a prayer warrior for them and for others of the church and for her family. She did believe in prayer and encouraged us to pray.

She was church clerk for 21 years and deaconess for quite a few years. She taught VBS every summer and that's when Bible School lasted for 2 weeks. She loved missions and held offices in the Ladies Missionary Society. She loved to hear from the missionaries and joyfully gave to them.
