Special Business Meetings following the morning worship service on October 28th

The first will address a proposed amendment to the Indian Creek Baptist Church Constitution. Here is the proposed amendment:
"In such an event that an officer is unable to fulfill the obligations of his or her office for the duration of his or her term, the official board has the authority to replace the officer at any regular church meeting with a three-fourths vote of approval. In the event that particular offices (i.e. janitor, organist, pianist, secretary, and treasurer) cannot be filled by a member of our congregation, a candidate or firm (i.e. CPA firm) from outside of our congregation may be selected, and compensated if appropriate, to fill this office until such a time as a member of the church is approved. The approval of this non-member or firm requires a three-fourth vote of approval at any church meeting."

The second meeting, to begin immediately following the conclusion of the first, would bring a proposal up for discussion and a vote (if there is a motion and a second to vote on the proposal). This proposal will ask for the duties of the church treasurer (balancing our checkbook, paying bills, drafting a monthly and annual report, reimbursing expenses, etc.) to be transferred to McClure & Wolf LLC, an accounting firm in Uniontown that currently handles our payroll services. If approved, this would go into effect unto such a time as someone in our church family is willing and able to fulfill the office of church treasurer
